

A Flood of New Beginnings

LOGLINE:

When his son's death is broadcast live as a viral ratings-grab, a devastated father takes "serious action" into his own hands, hunting down the news team that chose a scoop over a human life.

SUMMARY:

In the eye of the storm, a father's grief becomes a nation's wake-up call. Hanri had the quintessential American dream: a Harvard degree, a successful law practice, and a beautiful family. But when a Category 4 hurricane shatters his life, the dream turns into a televised nightmare. As news cameras roll—capturing the tragedy rather than intervening—Hanri's young son, Jamie, is swept away in a flash flood.

Every year, **more than 200 people die in floods**, and **many of them are children** just like Jamie. Driven by a devastating loss that occurs amidst **\$8 billion in annual U.S. flood damage**, Hanri enlists his powerful family of Egyptian attorneys to do the impossible: take on the American legal system. They aren't just seeking justice for one boy; they are fighting to change the laws that failed to protect him, aiming to stem the tide of the **\$40 billion lost to flood damage worldwide annually**.
